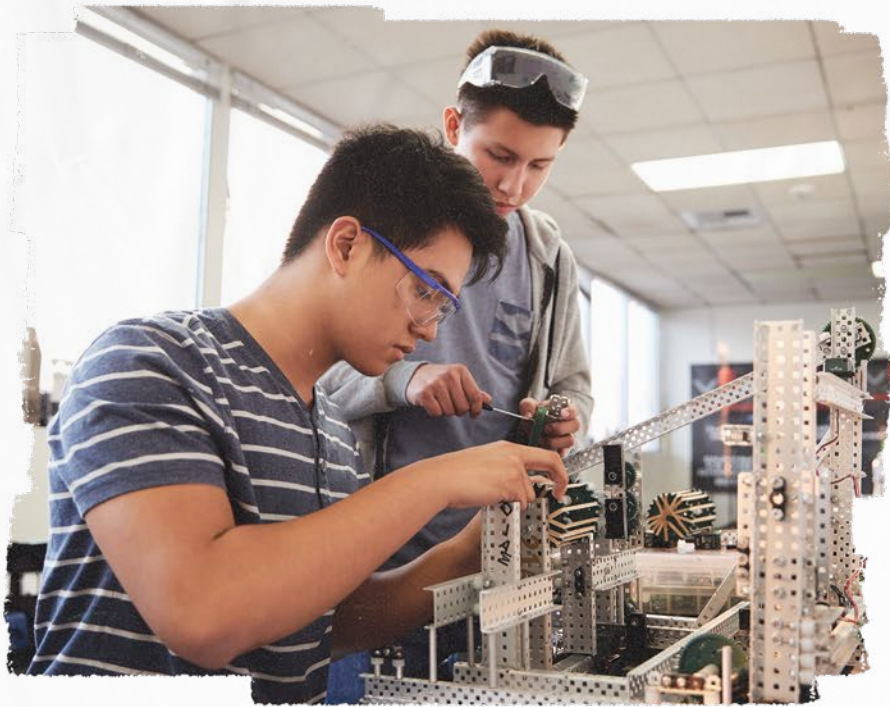

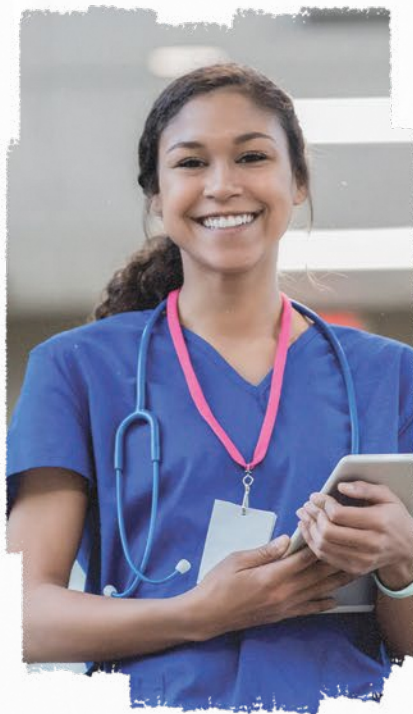


WHAT IS THE BUILD DAKOTA SCHOLARSHIP?

APPLYING FOR BUILD DAKOTA

SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

HOW DOES IT WORK?

The Build Dakota Scholarship is a full ride, not a free ride. Following program completion, each student works in their field of study for at least three years in South Dakota. In return, the scholarship covers tuition, fees, books and other program expenses.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Scholars of all ages are welcome to apply. This includes both in-state and out-of-state students.

WHAT'S AN INDUSTRY PARTNER?

Students can earn a Build Dakota Scholarship through the application process – or by finding an industry partner. What are those? An industry partner is a business that sponsors students and commits to paying a portion of their program expenses. Build Dakota picks up the other portion. The student earns their degree while they train, while the employer gains a skilled employee.

We are always adding new partners. Even if you don't see a business you're interested in on the list, ask them about Build Dakota or contact the technical college with questions or to help connect.

GETTING STARTED

THE PATH TO APPLICATION

STEP 1

Gain real-world experiences in your chosen field through part-time work, job shadowing and working with your guidance counselor.



STEP 2

Apply to your technical college and reserve a seat in the program. This can be done up to 18 months prior to applying for Build Dakota. Apply early! Some colleges allow their industry partners to start reviewing applications in January.



STEP 3

Visit the Build Dakota website. Click on the logo of the college you plan on attending. This will take you to the scholarship application at that college. All students are encouraged to apply even if you don't already have an industry partner.

PATHS TO PARTNER MATCHES



IF YOU ALREADY HAVE A PARTNER SECURED, there will be questions for you to provide this information in the application.

Your technical college will contact an employer on your behalf if they have questions or you need assistance with that process.



APPLY WITHOUT A PARTNER and your technical college will share your application with partners hiring in your field.

You may be contacted by employers for next steps. We recommend you apply early in the application window as employers reach out quickly.

APPLICATION PERIOD: JANUARY 1 — MARCH 31

WHAT'S THE COMMITMENT?

A Build Dakota Scholar agrees to:

- Enroll full-time in a Build Dakota Scholarship-eligible program at a South Dakota technical college (Lake Area Technical College, Mitchell Technical College, Southeast Technical College, or Western Dakota Technical College). Diploma programs typically require 1 to 1.5 years to complete and AAS degree programs require 2 years.
- Work full-time in South Dakota in the field of study for a minimum of three years following program completion.
- Maintain a 2.5 cumulative grade point average.
- Adhere to the technical college's attendance policy.
- If the scholar has an industry partner, the partner may have additional requirements outlined in a separate contract before the commitment is finalized.



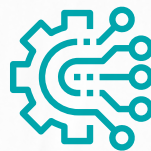
BRINGING IT ALL TOGETHER

What does everyone get out of this? STUDENTS

- Increases opportunities for career exploration
